

Which Study-Track might be the best for me?

Each study-track can accommodate a slight range of language ability among the students – the table below gives a general idea of how many college-level French credits a candidate would have either achieved, or tested out of, prior to each series of study-track options. *(e.g. If a student tests out of beginning “101 level” French due to French progress in high school, then that would still count as 3 credits for the purposes of this table.)*

Your French professor can also help you in deciding which track would be the best fit for you at your current level of French study . . .

Candidates for Study-Tracks in each of the following series would typically have achieved already the following number of university credits . . .
“A” Track Series	6-8
“B” Track Series	9-11
“C” Track Series	12-15
“D” Track Series	18 +
“E” Track Series	24 +
